The moment a result reaches a manager, the learner answers what they think is expected rather than what they think. The quiz then measures compliance, not understanding.

A learner reopens seven questions after finishing because nothing is watching. It is the only learning behaviour this arrangement produces, and it would vanish the moment a manager was given a screen.
