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Fictional document, produced for demonstration. **The agent does not pick the more recent source**: a note may clarify a special case without replacing the general rule, and material may have been updated after the note without the file date showing it.

Source	Date	What it describes
Module 4 material	Dated	One order of steps
Procedure note	19/05/2026	Another order

The answer given since the flag

"On this point, module 4's material and the note of 19/05/2026 do not say the same thing. Here are both passages. The question has been put to [contact]; until they answer, do not rely on me for this step."

What that answer contains

Element	Provided?
Both passages, quoted	Yes
The named contact	Yes
An explicit warning not to rely on the agent	Yes
An answer	No

What it costs, and what it avoids

	Value
Learners given that answer instead of a clear one	22
Learners who could have been taught a procedure backwards	22

The flag went to both authors together. It is the only recipient that stops each from assuming the other is current.

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
