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Fictional document, produced for demonstration. **The agent does not say which must be revisited.** An old clause is not an invalid clause, and revisiting a signed contract requires an amendment, hence the other party's agreement.

The three amendments of 12/06

Amendment	Nature	Contracts affected of the 23
Liability clause rewritten	Substantive	23
Data-processing mention added	Substantive	23
Internal cross-reference corrected	Drafting	6

The third amendment affects only six contracts of twenty-three. Counting all twenty-three as "affected by three amendments" would open seventeen files with no

purpose.

The 23, by renewal date

Renewal period	Contracts	What it allows
Before December 2026	9	New version with no negotiation
First half 2027	7	Same, later
Second half 2027	4	Same
No renewal date	3	Amendment required

The cause, and its fix

Element	Finding	Fix proposed
Template location	Two copies, one in a shared folder	A single location
Nature of the fix	—	A setting, not an instruction

An instruction to stop using the old copy would hold for a few weeks. A template that exists in one place holds on its own.

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
