Manual edits over twelve months

Block edited	Share of edits	What it indicates
Scope	31%	The block is too generic
Payment terms	22%	The cases provided do not cover practice
Service levels	14%	Absent from the template
8 other blocks	33%	Occasional

Sixty-seven per cent of edits fall on three blocks. Those are the three to revisit, and that finding comes from no judgement: it comes from what drafters did with their own hands.
