Fictional document — demonstration example

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **Indexing means reading the content of every document so it can be found by what it says, not by the file name or the folder it sits in.** Nothing is copied, nothing is moved, nothing is renamed: **Ventaline's current paths keep working exactly as before.**

The six connected sources

Information searches logged over the month	2,900	—
Searches re-run word for word on a second source within ten minutes	1,276 — 44 %	A search re-run identically elsewhere is a search that did not succeed the first time
Average duration of a successful search	16 minutes	Of which 60 % querying the sources one after another
Searches ending with a question put to a colleague	35 %	The most expensive item: it costs twice, the person searching and the person interrupted

The three items unified search shifts

Item	Today	With unified search	Change
Querying the sources one after another	60 % of the time spent on a search	8 %	–52 points
Tracing the original location and the version that governs	30 %	4 %	–26 points
Asking a colleague to find a document	35 %	6 %	–29 points
Duration of a successful search	16 minutes	5 minutes	–11 minutes

What the index contains, and it is the question an IT department always asks: what is needed to find a document where it is — its location, its date, the terms it carries. **It does not contain your documents.** A deleted index loses no file; that is what makes leaving possible in half a day.

Connection happens source by source, and each can be removed without touching the others. Ventaline can start with the two file repositories and the intranet, measure for a month, then decide the rest on what it actually returned.
