Five acts kept by HR — that is what lets the agent work alone on everything else

The act, kept by HR	Why it is theirs
Open a medical document	Once read, it cannot be un-read
Delete an item	A deletion cannot be recovered
Open an access	Closing it does not undo the reading
Lift a restriction, even its own	It would suffice to convince it it was wrong
Guess a document's nature	Misfiled, it takes on its heading's rights
