What you gain by asking for no reason at all

What the agent does	What it brings you
The plan is computed on the constraint alone	Childcare, medical appointment, car share: the reason changes nothing in the plan, and it never enters your logistics tool

What the agent does	What it brings you
Every constraint is handled on its own	Your logistics tool never becomes the instrument that measures who has a complicated life at the moment
Finish time, unavailability, zone to avoid: the three forms are taken as they come	The driver declares in one line, operations have nothing to investigate, and the day's plan takes it in

Wording used when a round becomes impossible

"This round cannot be done with today's availability" — not "X is unavailable".

The constraint is kept **for as long as it is valid, nothing afterwards.**

Scope of this document: the service operated by Blue Lemon Agent.
