Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **The second list is the one that commits the centre.** The nine closed fields are technically reachable in the practice software: they are not opened to the agent, and that list is what proves minimisation — not a statement of intent.

The 18 open fields

The 9 deliberately closed fields

Medical history	Yes	No administrative use — opening it would add nothing and expose everything
Current treatments, in detail	Yes	The referral does not depend on the molecule
Test results	Yes	No protocol rule depends on them
Specialists' letters	Yes	Belong to the record, not to the front desk
Consultation notes	Yes	Likewise
Prescription history	Yes	Likewise

Field available in the software	Closed to the agent	Reason
Detailed billing data	Yes	Handled by the administrative officer
Patient-practitioner correspondence	Yes	Its confidentiality has no reason to be shared with the front desk
Practitioner's personal notes	Yes	They have no recipient at all, the agent least of any

What becomes of clinical free text

Operation	Done?	Detail
Copied word for word, time-stamped	Yes	In quotation marks, in the "reason as stated" field
Passed to the practitioner in full	Yes	Average 1 min 40 against 2 h 50 before
Summarised	No	A summary is already an interpretation
Sorted, labelled, scored	No	No degree of urgency is computed from symptoms
Searched for clinical keywords	No	Only the 14 formulations of the urgent circuit, listed by the lead physician, are matched

1,480 requests contained clinical free text over the quarter. All of them went to the practitioner concerned, in full, in **1 minute 40** on average. **This is the one place where administrative speed serves the patient directly.**
