Three columns that never blend into one another

The “number of people” box stays empty, and that is a choice. Writing zero would be false; writing a reassuring range would be an estimate that would have to be retracted. A declared unknown gets completed; an invented figure gets withdrawn.

Encryption, and why it does not apply here

Element	State observed	Effect
The provider's database	Encrypted at rest	Not affected by the export
Export of delivery files	In clear	It is this export that left

Article 34(3)(a) GDPR waives communication to data subjects where the controller has implemented measures “that render the personal data unintelligible to any person who is

not authorised to access it”. The measure existed on the database, not on the export: **the exception does not apply on this scope**. This finding is presented with the item that establishes it — the provider's encryption inventory — and the final assessment belongs to the controller.
