The four redactions are reversible and were validated by the privacy officer on 07/09. The original version stays in the file, with the reason and the author of the validation: a redaction that cannot be undone, or whose author is no longer known, does not stand up before an inspection.

Your remedies

If this reply does not appear complete to you, you may refer the matter to the privacy officer of Maison Aurore and then, where appropriate, to the Commission nationale de l'informatique et des libertés. This statement is made under **Article 15(1)(f) GDPR**, which lists “the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority” among the information owed to the data subject **where access is granted**. Article 12(4) covers the distinct case where the controller **does not act** on the request.
