What Regulation (EU) 2026/1744 did not do, and the shortcut is circulating: it did not postpone the AI Act. 2 August 2026 remains the general date of application. Only the Annex III and Annex I obligations were moved.

The limit of this document: it does not say which regime applies to a given system. That depends on its purpose, its context and the people concerned, and it is assessed
