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Delegation moves the execution, not the duty to know what runs · fictional document

Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. Both managing general agents, their tools and their contracts are invented.

Agent A — pre-assessment tool for pre-authorisation requests

What the delegation agreement says	What the agent declares	What the AI agent can verify
No mention of automated processing of requests	Tool in service since March, supplied by a third-party vendor	The application endpoint exists and has called a third-party service since 4 March
General sub-processing clause, with no technical schedule	No model card provided	No supplier document in the vault

A contractual gap, not an inventory gap. The use case is real and declared; it is the clause that did not follow the tool. The fix is the amendment, not the register.

Agent B — incoming document classification

Declared, documented, version known, model card in the vault. **Nothing to report — and that is information in itself:** a portfolio where everything is "to be assessed" cannot be prioritised.

The three role hypotheses, and what each entails

Hypothesis	What would trigger it	Obligations it entails	Who settles it
The mutual supplies the tool to the agent	The tool is procured by the mutual and made available	Widest obligations on the mutual's side	Head of compliance
The mutual mandates it contractually	The delegation agreement prescribes the tool or its output	Shared obligations, to be written into the amendment	Head of compliance, with legal
The agent chose it alone	No contractual prescription, autonomous choice by the delegate	Duty to know and to oversee, without substituting	Head of compliance

The AI agent adopts none of these three. They are worked through, quantified in obligations, and put on the table. The choice binds the mutual: it carries a signature.
