What the trail keeps in every case

Every output of the agent carries **the source it comes from, the date of the finding and its status** — established fact, assumption, proposal or signed decision. **A proposal keeps its "not approved" label in every export**, including when it is detailed enough to look like a conclusion. It is that label which stops preparatory work being read, six months later, as a ruling.
