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4,700 applications matched against their supporting documents · fictional document

Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **A flag is a discrepancy between two documents in the same file, never a judgement on a person. It enters no score, appears on no committee note, and turns into nothing until a caseworker has checked it with the applicant.**

What the matching flagged, and what the checking gave

The figure that does not flatter the agent: 25 files looked at for nothing out of 63. The gap comes from a single cause: in 19 of the 25, the tax assessment notice on file covered the previous year because the new one was not yet available at the filing date — the comparison bore on two different tax years.

The tightened rule, run again over the 4,700 applications of the year just ended

What changes in the rule	Comparison of declared income with the reference taxable income	The same comparison, preceded by a check that the tax year of the notice matches the filing date	—

The tightened version is written and tested: it keeps all 38 founded discrepancies and spares 19 examinations. It takes effect only when the head of service approves it — and that is precisely what makes it enforceable against an applicant who would contest its effect. **The writing and the measuring are done; the decision takes ten minutes.**

What a flag actually produces — the 24 drops in income

Situation found	Households	Effect for the household
Job loss or end of contract after filing	11	Eligibility reopened on a home size the household had ruled out asking for
Move to part-time work or long-term sick leave	7	Rent-to-income ratio recalculated, access to homes ruled out until then
Separation with one income leaving the household	6	Composition and income updated the same day
Total	24	24 households told, instead of 24 households that did not know

Across 63 flags, the most frequent outcome was not a check: it was a letter inviting the household to update a file that had become more favourable to them. That is what matching documents does when it looks at both directions of the discrepancy.
