This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **The legal references quoted are real; the figures and names are invented. Everything asserted here can be checked on the machine, with one command — that is the point of the document.**

The two possible architectures, and what separates them

	Local inference	Dedicated resource hosted in France
Where the model computes	On a machine belonging to the office	On an isolated resource, in France, under French law
What leaves the office's network	Nothing	The encrypted stream to the dedicated resource, and nothing else
Sharing with another organisation	None	None — the environment is dedicated to Habitat des Trois Vallées

What the office administers	One machine and its backups	Nothing — operations are provided

Local inference, in one sentence: the model computes on your machine. The contents of a tax assessment notice, of an emergency accommodation certificate or of a social services report **cross no external network to be processed**. That is the route chosen at Habitat des Trois Vallées.

The agent's technical account	—	Read-only on the national registration system, tenancy management and the document repository	No write permission — verifiable with one command

Log since go-live: 0 out-of-role accesses across 5,900 files. The log carries who consulted what, when, and what the system produced — it is the document the office produces when an applicant exercises their right of access, and it comes out in one minute instead of a reconstruction.

One precision that matters, and that separates a rule of law from a rule of caution: the high-risk classification of Annex III **prohibits nothing**. It opens a regime of documentary and oversight obligations. **What really forbids automating an allocation is article 22 of the General Data Protection Regulation** — and that is already in force. **Both are held by the same arrangement: the committee decides, the agent prepares.**
