Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **The measurement bears on files and on the service's deadlines, never on what an individual officer does. The 3,100 letters requesting a missing document are written and await the reading of five templates: the office reads, changes a word, and the head of office signs.**

One hour of reading covers the 3,100 files. Each letter names the document, cites the line of the service note that requires it, carries a filing deadline and recalls the three ways to submit it — desk by appointment, online service, post. **A document request that cites the line requiring it is a request an applicant does not challenge, and**

a lawyer does not rewrite.

Those 51 implied refusals are no officer's fault: they follow from sixteen case officers handling 12,000 files, writing 3,100 letters and answering 26,800 enquiries.

That is exactly the load the agent absorbs without taking anything away from anyone — and counting deadlines is a calculation, not an appraisal: it runs every night across the 12,000 files, and it prints.
