Why this gap is published rather than quietly fixed: a watch whose blind spots are unknown reads as a complete watch, and **that is exactly when it becomes dangerous.**

The list of six sources is the boundary of what I see; anything not on it, I do not see, and you should be able to read that here rather than discover it on a case file.
