Applicable rate: € per kilometre — **to be set by the committee** (see the gap in the appendix)

The rest of the note, ready

"Travel expenses incurred for the association are reimbursed on a monthly expense claim, submitted before the 5th of the following month, with a travel receipt or a signed statement of mileage. The treasurer approves and reimbursement follows the next month.

The amounts paid are not reproduced, and neither is the rate. Putting them here would mean publishing two contradictory figures in the very document meant to settle between them. Only the direction of the gap is shown.

What would be matched in future, on your approval

Trigger	Who receives the gap	What you gain
Claim received	Treasurer	The gap goes to the treasurer and to her alone: you fix the rate without losing the volunteer
Quarter ended	Committee — how many claims, how many gaps, in which direction	The committee decides on the rate, not on people: no ranking by name circulates

A volunteer should not discover a rate discrepancy in an automated message. That is the kind of message that loses you a volunteer, not the kind that wins you compliance.

Scope of this document: the service operated by Blue Lemon Agent. For an agent deployed at your premises, the applicable location is that of the architecture set out in the quotation and verified before commissioning; local execution is announced only for the configuration explicitly described and accepted in the quotation; the applicable isolation depends on the deployment mode set out in the quotation, no dedicated isolation being presumed; the encryption mechanisms in transit and at rest, their components and key management are those documented for the architecture chosen; roles and permissions are configured and accepted for the identities and systems actually connected; the events logged, their content, their retention period and who may access them are defined for the deployment chosen.
