Fictional document — demonstration example

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Fictional document, produced for demonstration. **The only version that can be relied on is the one that was filed.** That is a fact, not an opinion — and it heads the page because it governs how the whole table reads.

The three differences that bear on the meeting of 26/09

Article	Filed version (2019)	Internal version ("amended 2022")	Consequence
11 — proxies	2 proxies per member	5 proxies per member	Composition of the vote
9 — quorum	One third of members	One quarter of members	Validity of the meeting
13 — board terms	3 years	2 years	Who is standing down and who is not

Article 9 is the most serious of the three. A meeting held under a quorum that is not the one in the operative constitution produces challengeable decisions — including the election of the treasurer, whose term ends that day.

The other six differences

5 — subscription	Refers to the internal rules in one version	None
7 — expulsion	Wording	None
15 — financial year	Same dates, different drafting	None

What was looked for, and what was not found

Document	Looked for	Found?
Minutes of the 2022 meeting	Yes	Yes — records a vote on the constitution
Appendix to the minutes (text voted)	Yes	No
Receipt of an amending declaration	Yes	No
Official gazette publication	Yes	No

Two hypotheses remain open: the amendment was voted and never declared, or the internal text was changed without a vote. They do not have the same consequences, and nothing on file allows a choice.
