Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for demonstration. **Letter unsent, and no crew is stopped**. Stopping a subcontractor is a site decision, with a cost, a programme and a person on the other side.

Body of the letter

Dear Sir or Madam,

On 24 July 2026 we sent you the subcontract declaration for the firm named above, for the trade and amount stated in it. You acknowledged receipt on 25 July.

To date we have received neither the acceptance of the subcontractor nor the approval of their payment terms.

Their crews have been working on site since 27 July, in accordance with the programme you approved.

We should be grateful if you would return the signed acceptance, or tell us what you are

still missing in order to do so.

What is enclosed

The last line matters more than it looks. A client slow to accept often cites a missing document. Enclosing them all, at the outset, removes the argument before it is made.

Flagged without being decided

Work continuing while awaiting acceptance: ☐ continues · ☐ suspended · ☐ continues, with a letter informing the subcontractor of the position

The third box exists because it is the only one that also protects the subcontractor. It is not ticked: that is a company decision.

Scope of this document: the service operated by Blue Lemon Agent. For an agent deployed at your premises, the applicable location is that of the architecture set out in the quotation and verified before commissioning; local execution is announced only for the configuration explicitly described and accepted in the quotation; the applicable isolation depends on the deployment mode set out in the quotation, no dedicated isolation being presumed; the encryption mechanisms in transit and at rest, their components and key management are those documented for the architecture chosen; roles and permissions are configured and accepted for the identities and systems actually connected; the events logged, their content, their retention period and who may access them are defined for the deployment chosen.
