Point 1 — exhibit relied on but absent. The other side's exhibit 14, relied on at paragraph 27 of their submissions of 3 February, does not appear on the schedule

served. A disclosure request has been prepared.

Point 2 — conflicting dates. The delivery note (Ex. 7) is dated 18/11/2024; the acceptance record (Ex. 22) states delivery on 22/11/2024. The four-day difference affects when the complaint period starts to run.

2. What remains to be settled

Whether the letter of 06/12 amounts to a contractual complaint or to termination of the agreement is not determined by the exhibits. **That assessment is the solicitor's** and is not proposed here.

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
