Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **The disclosure is not a configuration option.** Since **2 August 2026, Article 50(1) of the European regulation on artificial intelligence** requires that any person interacting with an AI system be informed, except where it is obvious. **In a public reception service it is not.**

What is announced, at every interaction

Element announced	Wording	Form
Nature of the service	« You are speaking to an automated assistant. »	Plain French
A human is available	« An adviser can answer you: ask at any time. »	Plain French

Element announced	Wording	Form
No justification required	The user need give no reason	—
Plain-language version — dedicated agent	Pass this content to the Accessibility, Easy Read and Translation agent	A dedicated agent, and it is not part of what this agent includes

Accessibility — applied to every document produced

Rule	Practical application	Why
Readable by a screen reader	Documents structured by headings, no decorative tables	Users with impaired vision
Sufficient contrast	Black on white, no text over images	Reading in the waiting room
Nothing essential carried by colour alone	Missing fields are highlighted AND marked « to complete »	Colour blindness, black-and-white photocopies
Type size	12 point minimum , large-print version in one click	About thirty prints a month

Until now, a large-print version meant redoing the layout by hand. It is the kind of task nobody counts and everybody postpones — **and the user who needs it is the one who finds it hardest to come back.**

What the disclosure spares the service

Feared question	Answer available	Where it is written
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« Are you replacing staff with a machine without saying so? »	The disclosure is made at every interaction and displayed in the waiting room	Dated display notice
« Can a user refuse the AI? »	Yes, at any time, without justification	Welcome message
« Who approves what is handed over? »	The lead adviser, systematically	Approval log
