Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document — the decree staged here, the procurement exercises and the amounts are **invented for the demonstration**; in service, the agent cites the real text with its official link and takes the amounts from your buyer profile. **Nothing is sent**: the alert and the 4 guide paragraphs await the signature of the head of the documentation service.

The three dates and the addressee — the header of every alert

Element	Value	Why it is at the top
Date of publication	Tuesday the 12th, Official Journal	It places the text; it says nothing about what has to be done
Date of entry into force	1st of next month — in 30 days	This is what the service looks for first, and it is what the 5 late texts were missing

Element	Value	Why it is at the top
Deadline for the service to act	The 17th — fifteen days before entry into force	So that the 7 exercises concerned are re-checked BEFORE they are published
Named service	Shared procurement team — 6 buyers, one named officer	An alert with no named addressee is an alert nobody picks up
Acknowledgement expected	From the named officer, before the 17th	The measurement covers what ARRIVED, not what was sent

The checking already done — 23 exercises in preparation, 7 affected

Three exercises are due to be published before entry into force, four after: those are not the same rules, and they are two separate lists inside the alert. That is the distinction the procurement team would have had to rebuild itself, exercise by exercise, from a text read at speed. It is done, it is dated, and it carries the estimated value and the sponsoring department of each — so the named officer can check it rather than redo it.

The draft alert, as it would go out — word for word

« **Monitoring alert — public procurement — action required before the 17th.**

What changes: the procedure thresholds for public contracts change. **From when:** the 1st of next month. **What you must do, and by when:** re-check, before the 17th, the 7 exercises in preparation whose estimated value falls in the affected band. The named list of the 7, with their subject, estimated value, sponsoring department and expected publication date, accompanies this message — it is split in two: 3 exercises published before entry into force, 4 after.

The procurement guide will be updated: 4 passages are affected (pages 7, 12, 19 and 31); the replacement paragraphs are submitted for approval.
