Reasoned opinion: inform the individuals. The concrete risk is targeted phishing — a message quoting the customer's name and the chain is far more convincing than an anonymous one. Information is precisely what defuses it. **Article 34 of the GDPR requires communication to individuals where the risk is high; the decision and the signature belong to the controller.**

Message to the individuals concerned — draft

« Dear customer, a supplier to whom we entrust our satisfaction surveys informed us on 19 August 2026 that one of its technical environments had been accessible without a password between 3 and 18 August. Your name, your email address and, for some of you, your phone number may have been consulted there. No banking data and no passwords were held in that environment. »

« What we recommend: if you receive a message presented as coming from our chain and asking you for a payment, a password or an identity document, do not reply and report it to us. We never ask for those by email or SMS. You can reach our data protection officer at the address below, and you have the right to lodge a complaint with the CNIL. »

Entry in the breach register

Article 33 of the GDPR requires every breach to be documented in an internal register, **including those that are not notified**. The entry is drafted: facts, effects, measures taken, and the reasoning that led to the decision to notify or not. It is what will make it possible, in two years' time, to explain why that decision was taken.
