Fictional document — demonstration example

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Fictional document, produced for demonstration. **No review tool publishes this figure**: the usual measure is the number of remarks produced, and it improves as the tool grows chattier.

Cause of incident	Incidents	Subtle?
Race condition	1	Yes
Time-zone edge case	1	Yes
Untested value	1	No
Query-scope error	2	No
Regression on existing behaviour	2	No

Five of the seven were not subtle. The agent does not explain them by their difficulty, because that would be excusing a defect that does not have that cause.

What approval times show

Of the 5 non-subtle incidents	Count
Merges approved in under 2 minutes	3
Merges approved beyond that	2

Two minutes is the time to read the agent's opinion, not the code. That is this trade's real risk: the agent does not let bugs through, it lowers attention.

Conclusion	Drawn?
My review does not replace yours	Yes
Reviewers are careless	No
I must be improved	Yes, and it is not enough

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
