Fictional document — demonstration example

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Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **Allocating pupils between classes is the head teacher's responsibility, not the town's**: the assistant produces enrolment lists and roll numbers, never a class composition.

The 4 gaps above 10% are flagged in July, not in September. That is the only window in which a conversation with the schools inspectorate about opening or closing a class can still have an effect — **in September it produces a statement of fact. The list of children subject to compulsory education that the mayor must keep is produced in the same pass**, current and dated.

The out-of-school rotas — 36 weeks, 9 schools, 972 sessions

Supervision ratios for out-of-school childcare are set by article R. 227-16 of the French social action and families code — one leader for ten children under six and one for fourteen above. The relaxed ratios of one to fourteen and one to eighteen applied here are those made available by the Vaubrières local education plan adopted on 4 July 2025: it is your own dated local act that grounds them, not a custom. The day the local education plan is not renewed, the 972 sessions are recalculated at the standard ratios and I tell you, before September, how many leaders are missing.

The 7 under-supervised sessions — flagged in July

The two schools concerned are those where supervised study and after-school care overlap on Thursdays. This is not a rota failure: it is a calendar effect nobody sees until the children are there. **Flagging it on 8 July rather than 5 September changes the date on which recruitment can start** — and that two-month shift is the difference between a post filled and a post left vacant.
