Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **The Vernier family and plot B-12 are invented. A grant deed is an act of the mayor: the assistant prepares it complete and verifiable, the signature stays where it belongs.**

The letter to the family, as it goes out after reading

« Dear Ms Vernier, **you asked us about renewing the grant where your parents rest, in Saint-Martin cemetery. That grant, made for thirty years on 14 September 1996, expires on 14 September this year.**

Renewal is possible and we can prepare it with you. You have two years from the expiry date in which to request it: the law provides for this, and we wish to tell you now so that you do not feel rushed.

To process your request we need: a copy of your identity document, proof of address, and **the written agreement of your sister, Ms Hélène Vernier, named in the 1996 deed as you are. This agreement is required because the grant passed to you both; it is not a formality we are adding.**

The applicable tariff is that of the town council resolution of 18 November 2025, an extract of which is enclosed.

If any difficulty arises, whatever it may be, write to us or call at the office: we will take whatever time is needed. »

Three drafting choices, each with a reason. The two-year period is stated at the outset, because a family receiving an expiry reminder often fears it has already lost everything. **The reason for the missing document is explained before it is requested**, because an unexplained requirement reads as an obstacle. **The last sentence opens a door**, and it is not a courtesy: across the year's 640 letters, it is the sentence that produces the most replies.
