On the statutory basis — 35 hours a week, 151.67 hours a month, 1,607 hours a year — that is more than twenty-four weeks, or more than five months, returned to your two officers. No post cut, no post created. The time goes back to the desk and to supporting families, which is the part of the work no tool replaces.

The review is still written and presented by the department: it is an act of the municipality, not a machine output. What the assistant brings is the figures, their date and the query that produces them — so that a councillor who asks where a figure comes from gets the answer in the meeting.

The protocol proposed for the coming year

The columbarium is 91% occupied, and 4 of the 14 expiries this quarter concern grants of less than two square metres. Protocol: over twelve months, record the share of requests going to the cremation site rather than to an earth grave, and compare it with the three preceding years. It is a protocol, not a forecast: if the balance does not move, the department will hear it from the assistant. What the municipality then does — extending the columbarium, opening a new section — is a decision entirely its own.
