Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document — households, amounts and movements invented for the demonstration. **No invoice is issued:** the billing file and the 1,222 letters await the head of service's approval, and everything can be undone with a word for as long as nothing has gone out. **The tariff parameters are not calculated by the agent: they are read from the community council's resolution.**

The parameters applied, and the article that sets each one

The lift log holds 1,187,400 lines over 24 months — residual waste lifts, kerbside packaging lifts, carded deliveries at the civic amenity sites and identified deposits at the 46 bring banks. **Only residual waste lifts enter the variable charge**, in line with article 4. The other lines serve service monitoring and the annual report — **they are never billed, and the agent does not add them to the total billed.**

The total billed, broken down to the euro

The 1.2% variance against the previous half-year, explained line by line

It is the variance, not the total, that the service spends most time hunting for. A total that moves 1.2% with no explanation takes half a day of searching and two meetings; **the same total accompanied by the 46 movements and the 109 lifts that make it up is read in two minutes. The named list of the 46 movements is attached to the billing file:** the service does not have to reconstruct it to answer a councillor.

The three covering letter templates

Extract from template B, the one that heads off the most complaints: « *Your invoice is 34% higher than the previous half-year. **This rise comes from the number of times your bin was presented for collection: 24 lifts this half-year, against 17 in the previous one.** The full statement, with the date and time of each lift, is overleaf. **Three levers can bring the next invoice down: only present the bin when it is full, compost food waste — a composter is provided free on request —, and take glass and textiles to the banks provided.** The service remains available to look at your situation.* »

What the full campaign weighs, across the 5 sectors

Nothing is issued, and the rule admits no exception: EVERY BILLED LINE TRACES BACK TO A TIME-STAMPED LIFT AND TO A RESOLVED TARIFF. The billing file and the 1,222 letters await the named approval of the head of the waste service, and the agent undoes the lot with a word for as long as nothing has gone out. Issuing an invoice is an act that binds the authority: it is not an act the agent rules out, it is an act it carries out as soon as the mandate is written — named scope, costed ceiling, review date, withdrawal with a word. The dial belongs to the service, and it moves both ways.
