Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **The legal references quoted are real; the figures and names are invented. Every line of this document can be checked on the town hall's machine, not taken on trust: the technical account's permissions display with one command, the log can be read, and the dry-run exit takes one afternoon.**

Local inference, in one sentence: the model computes on your server. The contents of a loan contract, of an annual financial statement, of an investment project not yet put to the council or of a supplier invoice **cross no external network to be processed**. That is the route chosen at Roche-sur-Ancelle.

Log since go-live: 0 out-of-role accesses across 8,500 entries and 9 contracts. The log carries who asked for what, when, what the agent produced and who validated it — it is the document the town produces if the regional audit chamber or the public accountant asks how an output was built, and it comes out in one minute instead of a reconstruction.

One precision that matters, and that separates a rule of law from a rule of caution: no text forbids a tool from preparing a payment order, a debt table or a

grant application. What the law separates is authorising and paying — and that separation is organic, not technical. **What the town decides is how far the mandate it gives the agent goes**; and that mandate it can write, or widen, the day it wishes.

Reversibility, verifiable before deciding

The dry-run exit takes half a day: the agent is switched off, the department checks that the payment-order chain and the debt module work exactly as before, it is switched back on. **The slot that costs least is the Thursday afternoon of the second week of August — 11 payment orders on average in that slot, against 214 on a Monday in December. Carried out on 13 August: no interruption of the accounting chain, no entry lost.**
