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Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **The contractors, the amounts and the project are invented. The application is built, not filed: the town council resolution and the mayor's signature remain the acts that bring it into being.**

The minimum contribution threshold holds, and with twice the required margin. Article L. 1111-10 of the French general local authorities code provides that a local authority acting as contracting authority for an investment operation must contribute a minimum of 20 % of the total funding provided by public bodies to that project. The town is at 40 %, that is €248,000 against €124,000 required as a minimum. The funding plan would therefore withstand a downward revision by one funder without having to be rebuilt — which is exactly what cost three weeks on the gymnasium application in 2025.

The two missing documents are named, their holder is identified and the request is written for each. Neither was missing through oversight: the site location plan existed in none of the town's files, and the energy report had never been commissioned from the design office. Eleven days of margin remain between the announced return date and the filing deadline of 31 January.

The funding plan table sits inside the body of the resolution rather than being referred to a separate document. That exact point earned a request for further information on the 2025 application — the assessing department could not verify that the assembly had approved the funding plan itself. **The correction costs nothing and saves two to three weeks of assessment.**

Final eligibility belongs to the funder, never to the agent — and saying so plainly is worth more than a promise. What the agent brings so that you can decide: the exact line of the funding rules that opens the scheme, the floor and ceiling rates, **and the last three comparable projects that funder supported in the department, with their amount and the rate obtained. The town chooses which ones it files; the applications kept are built straight away.**
