The explained variance is what saves the most time at review. Today a 2.1% variance between two months has to be hunted down: contracts are opened, compared, movements found. **Here the 21 movements are given up front, with the document grounding each** — the review is about the movements, no longer about the search.

The year's 620 changes of circumstance — where the delay is created

Last year's 61 adjustments of more than €40 are the real cost of the delay.

An adjustment lands on a family budget that was not expecting it, six months after the change that caused it — **and those 61 letters are what generates the following month's phone calls. Taking the change as it comes makes them disappear**

at source: the rate changes in the month the change takes effect, and the letter explaining it goes out before the invoice, not after.
