Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **A flag is not a finding: it is a request for verification addressed to a registry officer.** The AI agent compares written records with one another; **it never says which date is the right one.**

The four families of cross-check

Family	What is compared	What is raised	Number this month
Same item, two sources	A date appears on a decision received and on the case sheet	Both entries, each with its reference	7
Gap between two dates in the same file	The number of days recounted, compared with what the document itself states	The gap, with no conclusion	3

Family	What is compared	What is raised	Number this month
Document referred to and absent	A document referred to by another and not recorded	The referring document and the missing one	3
Duplicate	Same document, two records	Both records	1

Source	Wording copied	Reference	Date of receipt
Decision received	Wording on the document, copied word for word	Document no. 9	Recorded in the schedule
Case sheet	Wording on the sheet, copied word for word	Sheet, register entry	—
Gap recounted	The two entries do not match	—	—
Agent's conclusion	NONE — verification belongs to the registry	—	—

The unflattering figure, its cause and its fix

Item	Value
Flags raised	14
Real divergences	11
False alarms	3
Real cause	Documents from an older generation of forms carry the date in abbreviated form; the abbreviation was read as an incomplete date

Item	Value
Fix	Reading rule corrected, the three documents re-read
Real divergences on situations under thirty days	2

The flagging threshold belongs to the registry. Wide setting: more false alarms, no missed divergence. Tight setting: less noise, **and acceptance of missing more.**
The agent does not take that decision: it sets it out and applies it.

What flagging shifts

Step	Before	After
From « there is a doubt » to « the registry can rule »	3 h 40	20 minutes
Divergences resolved the same day	—	9 out of 11
Divergences requiring a document from a court	—	2
