Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document. The cases, parties and case numbers cited are invented for the demonstration. **These are DRAFTS: the clerk rereads, authenticates and signs. The clerk's signature is what gives the act its force; it belongs to the clerk and cannot be delegated.**

What each draft summons carries

Element	Source	What is checked before handing over to the clerk
Identity and capacity of the parties	Record sheet of the file	Consistency with the last act received on the file
Case number	General register	—

Element	Source	What is checked before handing over to the clerk
Hearing date, time and courtroom	Hearing list	Checked against the list, never against the file — that is the discrepancy of rule A
Chamber and formation	Case allocation order of 1 January	Allocation applicable at the date the case was registered
Mandatory wording	Registry template in force at the date of the act	Dated version reproduced exactly, never another
Address for service	Last act received on the file	Any divergence goes up to the clerk with both addresses and their dates

The 14 cases on the list for 12 March

Status	Cases	Detail
Complete drafts, ready for rereading and signature	12	All template wording present, address consistent, date checked against the list
Referred to the clerk for checking against the file	2	Incomplete or conflicting addresses — they do not go out

Case	What was found	The two elements handed to the clerk	What is asked
26/00412	Two conflicting addresses for the defendant	The one on the claim form (12/01) and the one on the last act received (04/02)	Check against the file before service

26/00587	Party domiciled at a third party's address, domicile wording missing from the record sheet	The act that mentions the domicile, and the sheet that omits it	Check against the file before service

These two lines are the best example of what the agent brings to a registry: they are not resolved, they are **found, documented and put on the table with both source documents**. Today they only come to light when the post comes back, or at the hearing. A summons served to an out-of-date address is an adjournment in the making: over 24 months, 68 adjournments were ordered for an acknowledgement of receipt not returned.

What summonses and notifications are worth over a year

What stays with the clerk, and what a mandate can cover

Act	Who does it	Why
Rereading the draft	The clerk	It is the clerk who answers for the act
Authentication and signature	The clerk	The signature gives the act its force; it cannot be delegated

Act	Who does it	Why
Dispatch of a batch already signed	The agent, under written mandate	Named batch, capped volume, review date, withdrawal on a word
Tracking acknowledgements of receipt	The agent, under written mandate	Half a day of assistant time returned per hearing
Chasing undelivered items	The agent, under written mandate	The clerk knows the day before the hearing which cases have no acknowledgement back
Setting or changing a hearing date	The court	A listing act, outside any mandate

The next step proposed, and it is measurable: the day before each hearing, the list of cases whose acknowledgement of receipt has not come back. Over 24 months, 241 summonses were in that position and 68 led to an adjournment. Knowing it the day before rather than in court means 68 situations to handle differently — a second service, an address check, a call to the legal professional involved — rather than a courtroom tied up for nothing.
