Fictional document — demonstration example

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **The measurement covers the ACTS and the DELAYS of the unit, never what a named carer does. No clinical content is interpreted here: the reconciliation compares a value present in a device with the same value present in or absent from the record.**

The three costed items — the calculation rule sits in front of each line

Conversion, single basis, rounded down: 1,218 hours is **more than thirty-four weeks of 35 hours** (34.8 exactly) and **more than eight months of 151.67 hours**. And set against the **84 residents over 52 weeks: more than sixteen minutes of nursing presence per resident per week** — 16 minutes 44 exactly. **The reference figure remains the 1,218 hours.**

What this document does not contain, deliberately: no indicator per carer. The 412 unverifiable series and the 1,148 missing readings are counted per resident and per protocol, never per person. A counter per carer would become a target; the target would remove the signal, not the problem.

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
