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Check of the four elements required by article R4311-7 of the French Public Health Code · fictional document

Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **The check bears on the PRESENCE and the LEGIBILITY of the four elements, never on the medical content of the prescription. No missing element is completed by the agent, and no dose is inferred: article L4161-1 of the French Public Health Code reserves establishing a diagnosis and treating illness to the physician.**

The four elements checked

Element required by art. R4311-7	What the agent checks	What it never does
Written	The document exists and is tied to the resident and the prescriber	Reconstruct an oral prescription

Element required by art. R4311-7	What the agent checks	What it never does
Qualitative	The product or the nature of the act is named and legible	Choose between two readings of an illegible name
Quantitative	Dose, form, frequency and duration are present and legible	Write a dose, infer it from an earlier prescription, or « correct » it
Dated and signed	The date is present and legible, the signature identifies a prescriber	Date or identify a signatory by inference

The year's 214 incomplete prescriptions

The request to the prescriber — the template, settled by the nurse coordinator

Section of the request	What it contains	Why
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Prescription reference	Unit sequence number, date received, arrival channel	The prescriber finds their document in ten seconds
Resident concerned	Name, date of birth, unit	Strictly necessary to continuity of care — art. L1110-4
The missing element, named	« Duration of treatment missing », « date illegible »	A precise request is handled in a minute; a vague one is put off
Image of the area concerned	The fragment of the document, not the whole document	Minimisation: the prescriber only needs that area
The field left blank	The answer — the element only the prescriber can write	Art. L4161-1

Nothing goes out without validation: the request is **prepared**, the nurse rereads and validates it, **and only then does it go out over secure health messaging. Over the year, 214 requests prepared, 209 validated and sent, 5 set aside by the nurse** — in all five cases the missing detail was on a second document received the same day that the agent had not matched. **Matching of documents received the same day was added on 14 September.**

Template request to the prescriber settled by the nurse coordinator, on: _____

Scope of this document: the service operated by Blue Lemon Agent. For an agent deployed at your premises, the applicable location is that of the architecture set out in the quotation and verified before commissioning; local execution is announced only for the configuration explicitly described and accepted in the quotation; the applicable isolation depends on the deployment mode set out in the quotation, no dedicated isolation being presumed; the encryption mechanisms in transit and at rest, their components and key management are those documented for the architecture chosen; roles and permissions are configured and accepted for the identities and systems actually connected; the events logged, their content, their retention period and who may access them are defined for the deployment chosen.
