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Fictional document, produced for demonstration. **This table does not conclude that you should warn them.** Warning 203 customers about a problem 192 have not met has a cost too, and the call is not a technical one.

All eleven who exported opened a ticket. The rate is 100%: in other words the problem is not silent — it announces itself the moment it is met. That is an argument for waiting, and it appears here alongside the opposite one.

The third box was not in the question asked. It is added because it exists: 38 accounts regularly exceed 100,000 rows, and they are the ones who will meet the problem first.
