Fictional document — demonstration example

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Fictional document, produced for demonstration. **This document does not say a tacit decision has been acquired.** It records three dates and quotes two articles — the legal characterisation belongs to the service.

Article R*423-23 of the French planning code. The standard assessment period is **one month** for prior declarations.

Article R*423-38 of the French planning code. Where the file does not include the required documents, the competent authority sends the applicant or the declarant, **within the month following receipt or filing at the town hall**, a recorded-delivery letter with acknowledgement setting out **exhaustively** the missing documents.

Day 47 falls after the one-month period provided by R*423-38. What that entails for the assessment period is a legal characterisation — it is not made here, and it is put as a question to the service.
