Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **It describes the architecture actually offered.** A court handles procedural exhibits, parties' identities and material covered by the secrecy of the investigation: **the most protected data in French law.**

The two deployment modes, at the court's choice

Mode	Where the computation happens	What leaves the network	For whom
On-premises inference	On one of the court's machines	Nothing	Courts with a server of their own
Isolated resource	On a dedicated server hosted in France, under French law	Nothing outside the European Union	Courts that would rather not run a machine

On-premises inference means the model computes on your machine: the text of a police record or an expert report crosses no external network to be processed. In both cases the resource is dedicated to the court: no pooling with another court — that is the condition for continuity of service.

What protects the procedural exhibits

Point	Implementation	What the court can write in its reply
Training	No procedural exhibit feeds a model, neither ours nor a third party's	« The exhibits train no system »
Write rights	The read-only technical account has no right to write to the applications	« The tool cannot alter any document, technically »
Encryption	In transit and at rest	« A stolen medium stays unreadable »
Role-based access	An investigation file can be opened only by the chamber seised and its registry — 9 roles for 44 staff	« Each member of staff sees only what their duties require »
Logging	Who asked for what, when, and what was produced	« 0 out-of-role access since go-live »
Hosting	France, under French law , architecture designed to reduce exposure to extraterritorial legislation, location alone not being enough to guarantee immunity	« Deployment objective: processing and access within the European Union »

The acts reserved to a person — and what the agent brings for each

Reserved act	Whose it is	What the agent has already done when it arrives
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Delivering and reasoning the decision	The judge's	The complete file, the chronology rebuilt, the exhibits matched to their number, the sources open alongside
Authenticating the document	The clerk's	The draft on the registry template, mandatory particulars checked, interval calculated case by case
Setting the hearing list	The presiding judge's	The state of files ready for judgment, and the 34 waiting on a single exhibit
Serving a decision on a party	The registry's	The service prepared the evening of the hearing, with its plain-language companion sheet
Assessing the scope of a court decision	The judge's	The published decisions, their dates, the extract of reasoning — never a summary that would stand in for the text

It is this division that gives the court's acts their value: a decision delivered and reasoned by a judge is **open to challenge, therefore defensible**; a document authenticated by a clerk carries authority. **The agent makes the file ready in minutes; the acts that bind stay where the law put them.**

The way out — checkable before committing, not afterwards

Item	What becomes of it on the day you stop	What stays with the court
The index	Deleted	No procedural exhibit was copied into it — the files have not moved by a byte
The log of enquiries and productions	Handed over in an open format, or destroyed	The court chooses, and the question is settled at go-live

The 11 standard answers and their plain-language and easy-read versions	Exported in a format readable without us	They remain usable at the reception desk
The companion sheets for summonses and notifications	Already in your files	Made of your own acts: they belong to you
The index of decisions delivered by the court	Handed over in an open format	Twelve years of decisions become searchable again
The subscription	Annual, no automatic renewal	It is renewal that requires a decision, not termination

A dry-run exit is offered at the end of the first quarter, half a day: we switch off, we check the court works exactly as before, we switch back on. **The first Friday in August carries 3 hearings against 9 on average — that is the date that costs least.**

Scope of this document: the service operated by Blue Lemon Agent.
