Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **Births and deaths make up 1,454 of the year's 1,736 records** — they are what decides whether staff have the time to talk to families. **The draft arrives built, every element with its document; the registrar's signature is what makes the record authentic and binding.**

Births — 1,240 a year, 890 of them to residents of other councils

Points calling for judgement	Flagged: antenatal acknowledgement to be attached, joint declaration on the choice of surname in the file, spelling of a forename differing between the declaration and the parent's document	The judgement
Annotation notices to the parents' councils of birth	Prepared — 890 times a year	Sending them, after sign-off
Drawing up and signing the record	Nothing	The registrar

890 times a year, the record the council draws up calls for a letter to another town hall — and it is the kind of letter that gets forgotten on a busy day. Prepared at the moment the record itself is, it goes out the same day: 890 a year, none deferred.

Deaths — 214 a year, and the family is sitting in front of the officer

What is ready during the interview	What it saves the family
The draft record, from the certificate and the documents produced	Waiting at the counter while it is keyed in
The list of documents to ask for — copies of the death record for the bank, the employer, the various bodies — with the number usually needed	Three trips back to the counter
The annotation notice to the deceased's council of birth	A step the family neither has to know about nor carry out

This is the gain that counts most: the fifteen minutes that preparing the record used to take are given back to the interview. **The one moment when the service receives a bereaved family now lasts fifteen minutes longer**, and it is the one item in this document that is worth more than its figure.

The volume, and the time given back

On a death as on a birth, what is written is final. It is the registrar who answers for it, and that is why the checking stays whole where the keying in disappears.
