The gain in hours is modest and stated as such: 9 hours. The gain that counts is elsewhere: over 24 months, all three of the town's administrative challenges turned on the perimeter of an order — two withdrawals, one narrowing. A single act, reasoned and bounded, is an act you defend once. The decision belongs to the mayor, and it is taken on those two lines.
