Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **This attachment publishes a figure unfavourable to the agent: 5 texts missed out of 86, and all five are resolutions of the municipality's own council. No order template was modified: templates are settled by the head of service and the chief executive of the municipality.**

Why this gap is published rather than quietly fixed: a watch that looks far and not near gives exactly the opposite impression of what it is worth. The list of five sources is the boundary of what I see; anything not on it, I do not see, and

you should be able to read that here rather than discover it on a challenged order.
