Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **Three sets of criteria and weightings are put on the table**, with **the ranking each would have produced on the municipality's three comparable consultations**. **The council chooses and settles the set before the consultation goes out, never after tenders come in.**

What is ready

Document	Where it comes from	What is left to the municipality
Specification	The municipality's 2024 roadworks consultation	Review of the description
Description of works	The technical officer's survey	Approval of the quantities

Document	Where it comes from	What is left to the municipality
Traffic constraints	The municipality's standard roadworks decree	—
Consultation rules	The municipality's template	The choice among three costed sets of criteria and weightings
Blank assessment grid	Built on the criteria chosen	Ready to receive the tenders

What the agent hands over when the tenders come in

What is handed over	What it contains
The grid filled in and scored	Criterion by criterion, with the calculation set out in plain words under each score: price against the lowest bid, technical value backed by the documents submitted, deadline in days
The ranking and the assessment report written up	Incomplete tenders included, each with the document that is missing and what the consultation rules say about it
The award	It belongs to the municipality — and the assessment report is what defends it before the public accountant and the unsuccessful bidders

The time it shifts, across the year's 4 consultations

Step	Before	After	Who does it
Drawing up the consultation documents	2 days	3 hours	The agent prepares, the secretary reviews
Assessing the tenders	A whole evening	40 minutes of reading	The grid is filled, the ranking stays with the municipality

Step	Before	After	Who does it
Annual gain	—	6 staff days	Time that was going neither to the counter nor to the acts

What is advised against, with figures

Option	What past consultations say	What is proposed
Consulting the same three firms as in the last three consultations	The same firm was the only bidder twice out of three	7 firms in the sector identified, having responded to comparable consultations in neighbouring municipalities, from the published award notices

A consultation without real competition does not give a market price. It is not a question of rules: it is the only way for the municipality to know what the works it is buying are actually worth.

What the municipality finds in its own archives

Comparable consultation	What was found
Roadworks, 2024	Specification, tenders received, deadlines actually met
Roadworks, 2022	Specification, a single tender received
Roadworks, 2020	Specification, a single tender received

The municipality stays below the thresholds that allow direct award, and the agent changes nothing about that: **it makes the consultation possible within the time a town hall secretary actually has.**
