Fictional document — demonstration example

This document is produced by the Blue Lemon Agent website to illustrate what an AI agent hands to its users. The companies, matters, amounts and people in it are invented. It has no legal, accounting or commercial value.

Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. **The agent checks completeness, prepares the receipt and hands over the pre-processing note that sets the project against the rules of the planning document. The shared service's case officer confirms or corrects it and writes their opinion; the decision belongs to the mayor, and it is their signature that makes it challengeable before an administrative court, and therefore defensible.**

The applicant is the person filing the permission request. Completeness is the check that every document required by the form is present. Pre-processing is the preparatory work that sets the project against the rules of the planning document, before the case officer rules on it.

What the agent does on a filed application

What the case officer and the mayor do with the note

What the note carries	What becomes of it
The project set against the written rules of the zone — footprint, height, siting, external appearance	Confirmed as it stood 39 times out of 47 by the processing service, corrected 8 times
Points to be checked on site and further documents to request	All 8 corrections concern on-site judgements, never a document nor a measurement
Opinion and decision	The opinion belongs to the processing service, the decision to the mayor — and it is their signature that makes it challengeable, therefore defensible

Minor declarations concerning works already started	3 out of 47	It assembles the three files — filing date, date visible on the photographic document — and writes the reminder letter on the municipal template, ready to sign	The mayor

The time the municipality loses on planning is in the incomplete files that go back and forth, and in the processing that starts again from scratch. The counter check removes the first; the pre-processing note clears the second.
