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Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. *A security patch is the update that closes a known flaw in a piece of software; until it is applied, the flaw stays open on the workstation or server concerned.*

What each of the 11 sheets carries

Heading	Content
Product and version	Exact, as installed
Workstations or servers concerned	The number, here — not an order of magnitude
What the flaw allows	In plain language, without vendor jargon
Application procedure	Taken from the vendor's documentation
Recommended window	Based on your quietest hours, taken from your own logs

The three critical patches of the month

Reach	Interruption	What is ready
340 workstations	None — overnight deployment	Applied through your deployment tool in one night
Print server	12 minutes	Window proposed: Tuesday 6.30 a.m. — no printing at that hour for three years in your logs
Business application	To be agreed	Vendor's agreement required — the letter is written, ready to go

The lead time, which is the whole subject

Measure	Before	Over the quarter
Time to apply a critical patch	31 days	4 days on average
Note for the chief executive	None	One page: number of critical patches and average time to apply

Putting a patch into production stays with the information systems security officer — and the agent hands it to him in four days, with the window, the procedure and the list of workstations concerned. **Those two figures are exactly the ones an authority is asked for on the day of an audit.**
