Fictional document — demonstration example

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Fictional document, produced for demonstration. **An automatic rerun turns a test that finds a real defect into a test that always ends up passing.**

Test	Failure rate	Reruns	Fails when...
1	1 in 6	68	Another test touches the same table
2	1 in 8	54	Same
3	1 in 5	61	Same
4	1 in 9	39	Same
5	1 in 7	48	Same
6	1 in 12	24	Undetermined
7	1 in 15	18	Undetermined

Five of seven fail only when another test touches the same table. That is a lead, not a conclusion: the agent supplies the correlation and does not say which of the two causes is the right one.

The two possible causes, and what separates them

Cause	Recognisable in the log?
The test depends on what it does not control	No
The code itself is unstable	No

What the agent does with the test

Action	Done?
Rerun it	No
Mark it flaky	Yes
Take it out of the merge decision	Yes
Disable it	No — it keeps running and reporting

A test rerun until it passes was already blocking nothing: it was wasting time without protecting.

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
