One hyphen apart. This is not presented as proof: a company may hold two domain names, and one may be perfectly legitimate. Both are given side by side so that someone reads them.

The check proposed

Step	Detail	Why
1	Call the supplier	—
2	On the number in the contract	Never the one in the email
3	Oral confirmation of the change	—
4	Change keyed by accounts	Never by the agent

A number appearing in a doubtful email leads, if it is doubtful, to whoever wrote it. That is why step 2 is spelled out rather than implied.

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
