Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. A moulder's cycle times, pressure curves and settings **describe its know-how better than a drawing does**. This document establishes **where that data is processed, who can read it, and what is logged**.

Hosted in France, under French law	No sensor data, no job history outside the territory
