



Case log — four-eyes review

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Two levels of analysis, one reasoned disagreement, access traced by purpose · fictional document

Fictional document — demonstration example

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Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. Roles, dates and reasons are invented. **Nothing is written into any real system. The names in the log are role names**: it is the role that answers for the act, and it is the role an inspection looks for.

Who saw what, when, and on what written grounds

Why the disagreement is kept rather than resolved

The analyst who works up the file is not the one who validates it, and the log keeps both names. Two reasoned opinions that diverge are worth more than a single opinion nobody discussed: it is the disagreement that shows, two years later, that the file was looked at twice. **Over the year, 6 disagreements were recorded, 4 of them settled in favour of the second level** — the figure measures how useful the review is, not how good the people are.

No generic role runs across the four purposes, and every access carries its grounds. The secrecy attached to a report requires that separation: **article L. 574-1 of the French Monetary and Financial Code attaches a criminal penalty to breaching the confidentiality** involved, which makes the access route a condition of going live rather than a usage guideline.

Decision awaited: Head of compliance and internal control — alert status, countersigned by the second level
