Fictional document — demonstration example

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Fictional document, produced for the demonstration. This statement is produced without a single line being typed by hand: **it is read straight from the sending platform, the short-message gateway and the CRM**. That is what takes sequence tracking from **60 % to 8 %** of the sales administrator's time.

Where each lead stands

Step	Channel	Leads reached	Comment
D+0	Email	402	A different text for each lead

The reply rate, compared on two levels

The gap has a cause and owes nothing to luck: the messages quote the original enquiry word for word, which the spring mail-merge did not. *The reply rate is the share of people reached who write back, whatever the sense of their answer* — an opt-out request is a reply, and it is counted as one.

The most important rule of the whole set-up fits on one line: nobody who replied receives the next message. **58 replies, 58 exits from the sequence within the second.** A follow-up sent after a reply is the one incident that discredits a sequence for good, and it cannot be taken back.

Segment on which to move the short message to D+2: _____
